
**STATE ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT
DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFIANCE (DNS)**

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL: West Sound Utility District received a petition for annexation of two parcels of property into the District's water and sewer service boundaries. Annexation is a prerequisite for obtaining water and sewer service from West Sound Utility District
