ACCOUNT PROCEDURES TO ADDRESS FIRE SPRINKLER SYSTEMS**

**WHEREAS**, RCW 57.08 authorizes water and sewer districts to establish water and sewer rates; and

**WHEREAS**, the District's Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution 538-15 on February 17, 2015, which modified water and sewer rate procedure changes; and




**THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WEST SOUND UTILITY DISTRICT HEREBY RESOLVES:**


**Section 1.** The Board of Commissioners hereby adopted changes to the policies which pertain to the water general facility charges as set forth in Exhibit "A".

**Table 1  
Water General Facility Charge (GFC) for 3/4-inch Meter  
2015 Fee Schedule**

<b>Plant Component</b>	<b>Total</b>
GFC – 3/4" Meter (Supply/Treatment, Storage and Transmission)	\$3,457

For larger meter sizes, the charge will be times the weighting factors provided in Table 2 below.

[1] For equivalent residential units (ERUs), through 3-inch meter. Larger meter sizes based on a 3/4-inch meter equivalency for AWWA Cold Water Displacement Meters.

[2] The District, at its discretion, can determine the GFC based on projected water usage (demand) for any meter size larger than a 2-inch meter, and equate that usage to an equivalent residential unit, which is currently 169 gallons per day per ERU, per the 2012 Water System Master Plan Update.

[3] Residential Fire Sprinkler Systems: Where a 1" meter is requested to accommodate an automatic fire sprinkler for a one-family dwelling, the GFC for a 1" meter shall be based on one ERU if the increase in meter size from 3/4" to 1" is required solely to accommodate the automatic fire sprinkler. The applicant shall provide documentation that a 3/4" meter is adequate based on the plumbing fixture count in accordance with the Uniform Plumbing Code.
