A RESOLUTION OF THE

WEST SOUND UTILITY DISTRICT BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AMENDING THE DISTRICT'S 2013-14 BIENNIAL BUDGET TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE REHABILITATION OF THE KRISTA FIRS WELL

WHEREAS, West Sound Utility District's Hydrogeologist, Craig Russell, identified the need for the District to rehabilitate the Krista Firs Well in order to improve the well's production efficiency; and

WHEREAS, there were no funds appropriated in the 2013-14 Water Capital Improvement Budget to fund the Krista Firs Well rehabilitation project; and

WHEREAS, the cost to perform the well rehabilitation work is estimated at approximately \$33,000 with additional capital expenses (removal of trees, reinstalling fencing, resurface work area) estimated at \$10,000; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WEST SOUND UTILITY DISTRICT HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The West Sound Utility District Board of Commissioners hereby approves the Krista Firs Well rehabilitation project as a priority objective for 2013 and agrees to shift \$43,000 of funding from the 2013 "Transient Voltage Protection at Two Pump Stations" capital project to the "Krista Firs Well Rehabilitation" project in the 2013-14 Water Capital Improvement Fund (91933) Budget.
